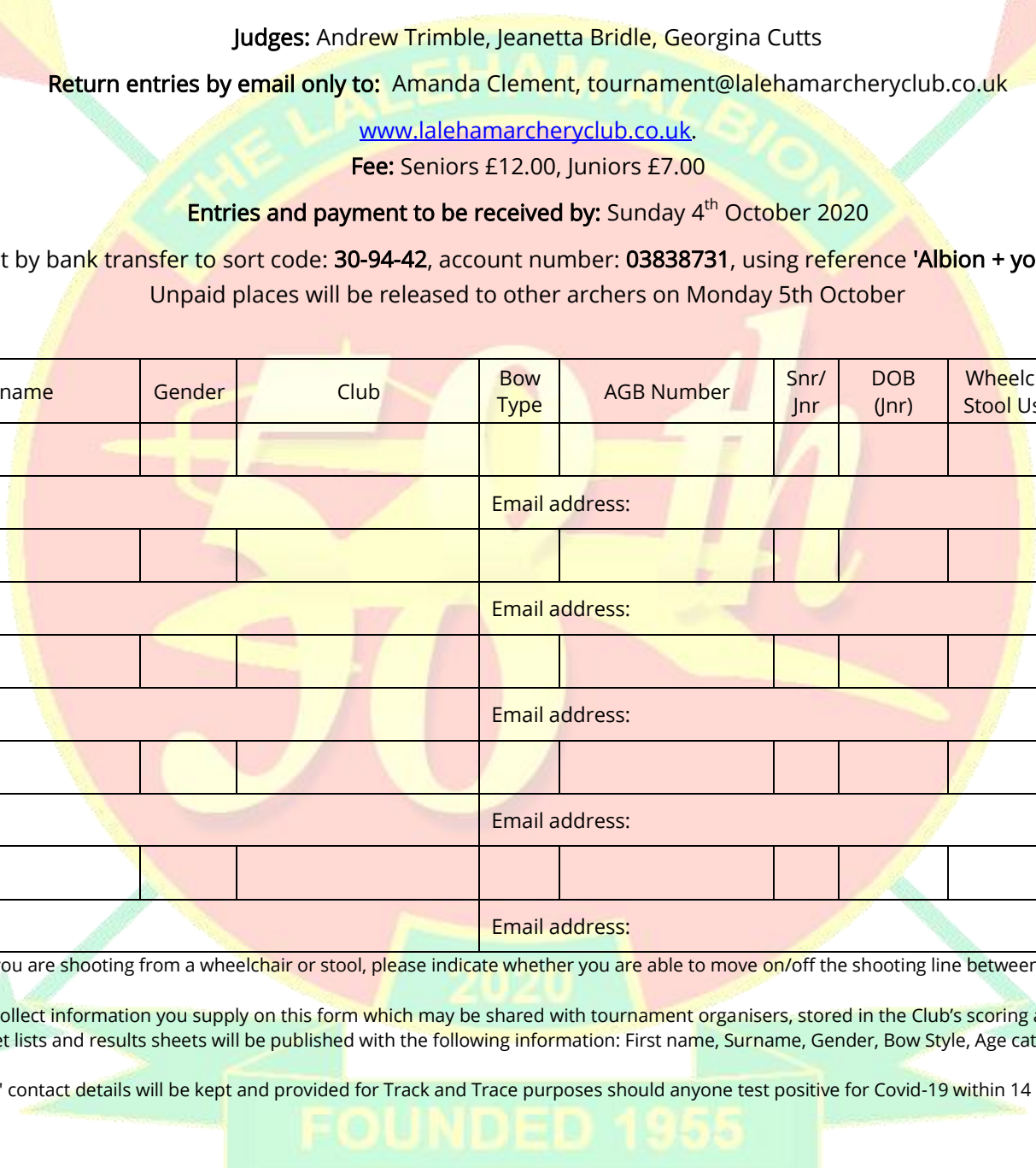

When you enter this competition, we will collect information you supply on this form which may be shared with tournament organisers, stored in the Club's scoring application and some of which will be shared with other competitors. For example, target lists and results sheets will be published with the following information: First name, Surname, Gender, Bow Style, Age category and Club name.

A record of attendees' contact details will be kept and provided for Track and Trace purposes should anyone test positive for Covid-19 within 14 days of the tournament.



You should ask yourself the following questions before attending: •Do you have a high temperature? •Do you have a new, continuous cough? •Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste? •Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days? •Are you in a lockdown area? If you answer 'yes' to any of these, then you should not attend the competition.

Please travel to the event alone. Spectators/coaches/drivers will not be allowed on the field of play and must stay by their cars. This is to meet AGB/government guidelines for groups of people and social distancing on the Field of Play particularly.

There will be no refreshments or food provided this year, so please bring lunch, hot and cold drinks, etc with you.

Unfortunately, lockdowns may also affect us, so be prepared just in case we have to cancel the Albion at the last minute.

There will be no awards ceremony this year. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in the following categories (dependent on entry numbers) and posted: Gents, Ladies, Junior Gents & Junior Ladies for Recurve, Compound, Barebow & Longbow

Would 2019 trophy winners please ensure trophies are returned to LAC, cleaned and engraved (if desired), by 27th September 2020 or, if you are shooting, please notify us by the same date if you intend to bring them with you on the day.

Archers competing at Record Status tournaments will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached. Please complete the form below for each junior archer to signify your acceptance of this condition of entry.

Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. Shooting will be on foam bosses and 122cm target faces, in ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes, in accordance with method 2 under Archery GB rules, with audible signals, lights and countdown timing clocks.

In accordance with the provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are required to register with the tournament organiser.

Archers with Disabilities: please let the tournament organiser know if you intend to bring an assistant with you or require any other assistance.

Archery GB membership cards will be inspected at registration. If new cards have not been received by the date of the shoot, please bring evidence that fees have been paid to Archery GB. In accordance with Archery GB rules, equipment will be inspected at all record status shoots. Under rule 201e, the archer is responsible for ensuring their equipment complies. Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party and the same person notified when the arrow is found.

Photographs will be taken at this event by individuals who have registered for photography in accordance with Archery GB rules. Senior archers who fail to make a declaration on this form will be deemed to have given consent to use of their photograph for publicity purposes. Parents/guardians of junior archers are asked to complete the form below to consent to such photographs of the junior archer being used with identifying details.

Mandatory drug testing: I agree to my son/daughter providing a sample for drug testing if required.
